Recognition awards are presented to honor individuals, clubs and organizations for services which have supported or advanced the ideals and aspirations of volkssporting. Recognition Awards presented at the AVA $19^{\text {th }}$ Biennial Convention include the following:

## IW Honors

The IVV may recognize individuals within the American Volkssport Association for services, deeds, and accomplishments concerning the international aspect of our organization.

## Hall of Fame

The AVA Hall of Fame Award honors an individual who has given at least ten years of service to AVA at the national, state and local level and has made exceptional contributions to volkssporting across several AVA regions.

## AVA President's Award

The AVA President bestows this award upon individuals, clubs or groups who through their exemplary display of volkssporting spirit are worthy of national recognition.

## Distinguished Achievement Award

The Distinguished Achievement Award recognizes individuals who have given at least eight years of extraordinary, unequaled exemplary service to the AVA. Personal contributions must have been made at an exemplary level at several stages of service, including the national level.

## Trailblazer Award

The AVA Trailblazer Award recognizes AVA Member Clubs that have made significant contributions to the development, maintenance or improvement of walking trails or to the support of trail related issues.

## Ted Ballman Memorial for Youth Award

The Ted Ballman Memorial Award recognizes the efforts of an individual or organization to create, enhance, or promote volkssporting programs for youth.

## Meritorious Service Award

The Meritorious Service Award recognizes individuals who have given at least five years of outstanding service to the AVA.

## Certificate of Service

The Certificate of Service recognizes individuals who have given at least three years of significant contributions to the AVA, appointed officials of the AVA, to members of all AVA committees.

## Certificate of Appreciation Award

The Certificate of Appreciation Award recognizes individuals, organizations and businesses for service to AVA on a regional, state, or club level.

Don with his brother and father were among those who began the American Volkssport Association. Don helped in drafting the first AVA constitution and bylaws. He served two terms as AVA Treasurer, during this time he received the Distinguished Service Award. In 2013 he received the Hall of Fame award. Don helped found the Michigan Pathfinders in Michigan and the Wandering Knights in Pennsylvania. While Stationed overseas during Operation Desert Storm and Desert Shield he set up the first Volksmarches in Saudi Arabia. His exceptional service at the local, state and national level, along with organizing events all over the world is outstanding. He is an exceptional leader and his love and dedication of our sport was unwavering. Don passed from this life March 9, 2015. He will be missed.
