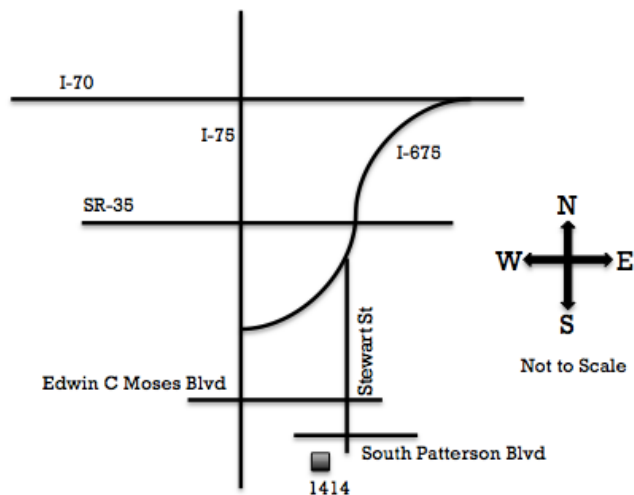
Breakfast is not included. Marriott has a full service restaurant.

***Each event will be available all three days, but on its "Featured Day" (as identified above), there will be manned checkpoints.**

Time: Registration will be open 8:00a – Noon. Finish by 4:00p. Multiple events can be stamped at the same time, once completed.

Trail: Carillon Historical Park is a 5K, rated 1A walk through the park and some of the buildings, including the replica of the Wright Brother's Cycle Shop (a National Park facility). Mostly hard surfaces, but will be moderately difficult for wheelchairs. Both trails suitable for strollers and wagons. Special programs are Carousel and Clock Tower. Restrooms, water, and food are available on the grounds. No pets allowed on this 5K. *Park opens at Noon on Sunday. Additional admission fee to park if walking trail more than one day. Hawthorn Hill (the Wright Brother's home) is 6K, 2A walk due to the long uphill to the house. The trail is through lovely, old neighborhoods on sidewalks. Will be difficult for wheelchairs due to the hill. No restroom on the course, but water will be available at the checkpoint. No Special Programs. *These will be Friday's Featured Walks.*

Wright Cycle Shop & Downtown Dayton – The trail will be two 7k loops, both rated 1A, taking in the historic sites of the Wright Brothers. The first loop takes you to the Wright Cycle Shop in west Dayton walking along the Great Miami River Recreation Trail and also past the site of their former home at 7 Hawthorn Street. The second 7k loop is through the downtown section of Dayton on city sidewalks and will pass numerous sites, buildings and sculptures associated with the Wright Brothers. Both trails are on hard surfaces, suitable for strollers and wheelchairs with curb cuts at most intersections. Some uneven sidewalks. *These will be Saturday's Featured Walks.*

University of Dayton – 5k Rated 1A: Surface, sidewalks & streets. After walking through Oakwood and past Ben and Jerry's Ice Cream Parlor,* we enter the campus. Pass the Recreational Complex with a Big Clock.* Spend a quiet moment in the Grotto of Serenity Pines. While crossing the Central Mall take in a 360 degree look at the campus. Enjoy the Dancing Waters Fountain by the Student Union. Peek into the College Chapel, Holy Angels Church and pass by college buildings too numerous to mention. Woodland Cemetery and Arboretum – 5k Rated 2B. Because of the long hill to the "Look Out" and some walking on uneven ground, wheelchairs, wagons or strollers are not recommended. Woodland Cemetery is one of the nation's five oldest rural garden cemeteries and a huge part of Dayton History. The Chapel by the Romanesque gateway features original Tiffany windows. The "must see" Mausoleum features 12 stained glass windows. Most of Dayton's heroes, including Wilbur and Orville Wright, inventors, business barons such as Charles F. Kettering, John H. Patterson, George P. Huffman and George Mead, just to name a few. Graves of humorist writer,

Irma Bombeck and poet, Paul Laurence Dunbar and the touching stone of "A Dog and Boy" will be passed. Over 3000 trees, including 9 "Champion Trees," on the Aviation Trail and listed with NRHP. This "Walk" also has great views of the Great Miami River, downtown Dayton and strolls through the "Fairground District" and past a Street Clock* on Brown Street. *Indicates Special Programs. *These will be Sunday's Featured Walks.*

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES:

"History, Mystery, Mayhem & Murder Tour" at Woodland Cemetery: Thursday evening, a touch of history and mystery including inventors, bank robbers, counterfeiters and murderers. This is not a Halloween or ghost tour. Walking tour over hilly and uneven grassy areas. Tour approximately one hour and forty-five minutes, one and one-half miles. Individuals carry a lantern during the tour. Tour would begin at 8:00 pm. A \$5 donation to Woodland Cemetery, per individual, is appreciated. Event can be accessed through the hotel shuttle.

Meet & Greet: Friday evening at 7:00p, the Meet & Greet will be held on the Outdoor Terrace with Fire Pits. There will be indoor space available in case of inclement weather. You will be able to sample from a Pasta Bar. This is a "tasting station" - NOT a full meal. Station will include cheese tortellini, gemilli, whole-wheat penne, alfredo sauce, marinara, Italian sausage, shrimp and chicken. Coffee & Tea included. *There is a bar located in the hotel and you may purchase drinks and bring them to the Terrace. **Cost: \$20. Limit 70**

Banquet: Saturday evening at 6:30p, the Banquet will be held on site, with a choice of three different entrees: Grilled Chicken Asiago, Blackened Mahi Mahi or Vegetable Cannelloni-Pasta Shells (Vegetarian option). All meals will come with Garden Salad, Grilled Asparagus, Roasted Marbled Potatoes, bread or rolls & one of two dessert options. Coffee & Tea included. After dinner, a National Park Ranger will speak about the Wright Brothers. **Cost: \$35. Limit 70**
