AVA Best Practices—On Publicity



Across the nation (seriously, Maryland to Hawaii) the word is to publicize events 3 months out. This is most easily accomplished on websites, through emails, and regular publications. The California Volkssport Association (CVA) publishes a quarterly magazine with a column devoted to each Traditional event and listing all YRE's and seasonals in the state. Washington and Oregon clubs jointly use a newspaper format and distribute copies to libraries and businesses as well as those already involved in walking clubs. Such forward publicity gives folks time to plan their participation and even link walking to family visits and vacations.

2017 Convention Update-Club Exhibit Tables and Paid Sponsorships





2019 Convention Planning in the Works as the Search for New Convention Ideas and Best Practices Continues...





Some of the areas the convention plan will address are a formal application and equitable selection process as well as baseline criteria for host venues, workshops, AVA events, exhibitors, keynote speakers, marketing, and entertainment. The plan will also address how to better finance the convention through registration fees, corporate sponsorships, in-kind contributions and other funding sources so convention costs are more reasonable for our members and the general community. The roles and responsibilities of the host site/club(s) and the National office will also be addressed.

The goal is to have a formal bid process/application ready to send out to state associations, clubs, organizations and other interested parties sometime in late February 2017. The application will outline base criteria sought in order to host the convention. Applications will be reviewed by the work group and the highest rated will be invited to present to the membership during the June 2017 Convention for their vote. The rating process is yet to be determined.




