The Pacific Region kicks off a year of celebration walks for AVA's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary January 9-11, 2026 in Boulder City, NV. Sponsored by the Las Vegas High Rollers & Strollers and hosted by the AVA Chairman, this weekend offers three unique walks you can do at your own pace.

Boulder City, 20 miles south of Las Vegas, is the only incorporated city in Nevada without gaming and home of the State's number one tourist attraction, Hoover

Dam. The town that built Hoover Dam is the quintessential small-town America.

Costs for On-site Registration:

- \$10.00/participant Registration Fee is required of **all** participants.
- \$4.00/participant for each walk, with or without receiving IVV Credit.
- All payments must be made at the Best Western Hotel at the LVHRS check-in table when you receive directions/maps to the walk start point(s). NO MONEY can be collected at walk locations. You will need to drive from the Best Western to each walk location.
- Pay by cash or please make checks payable to: **Las Vegas High Rollers & Strollers**
- 5K walk Saturday January 10<sup>th</sup>, 4-7:30pm without wine = \$4.
- For Best Dam Wine Walk with wrist band and glass = \$35; register and pay Chamber of Commerce at their Mobile Trailer for wine walk. ID required.

Everyone is welcome to participate in our recreational, non-competitive events. Always carry plenty of water. Drink before you're thirsty. Avoid the hottest part of the day and use sunscreen. Restrooms are generally available and will be designated on walk directions. Pets, if permitted must be on leash. Obey law and pick up waste.

## DIRECTIONS TO EVENT HOTEL

From Las Vegas take I-11/US 93 south to Boulder City Parkway, Exit 15B. At second light continue straight (name changes to Nevada Way). Best Western is on left about 3 blocks, just past 5<sup>th</sup> Street. If coming from Arizona, take Exit 2 to stop light, then left on Nevada Way.

## WALKING WEEKEND OPPORTUNITIES

All walks are self-guided with walking directions/maps. Walk during daylight hours only and carry water. You must drive to the start point of each walk. They do not start at Best Western.

**Historic Railroad Tunnels Trail, Sanction #130265** Walk any day January 9-11 at your leisure.  
Optional *group walk January 9, 9-9:30AM start.*



The Old Historic Railroad Tunnel trail in the Lake Mead National Recreation Area is a step back in time related to the construction of Hoover Dam and how building materials were brought to it in the 1930's. This gravel and dirt trail brings you through five mountain tunnels where the old railroad track used to be in place and delivered materials for the dam construction. You also get great panoramic views of Lake Mead and its mountain setting. Collect a stamp for your National Parks Passport at the Lake Mead Visitor Center. Strollers and wheelchairs may find the trail, while level, a little challenging.

**Bootleg Canyon, Sanction #130264** Walk any day January 9-11 at your leisure.  
Optional *group walk January 10, 9-9:30AM start.*



Get up close and personal with some giant animals at Bootleg Canyon Park. Then continue on the wide paved path of the River Mountain Loop Trail with rolling hills and magnificent views. Turn onto the wide sidewalks of Boulder City Parkway with several food places including The Patio at Chilly Jilly's (GREAT for Breakfast or Lunch with fire pit tables). Then head back up to the park passing the Nevada State Railroad Museum and the home of Fisher Space Pens.

**Veterans Memorial Park, Sanction #130036/Y2830** Walk any day January 9-11 at your leisure.  
Optional *group walk January 11, 9-9:30AM start.*



Walk begins in beautiful 25-acre Veterans Memorial Park famous for 4th of July celebrations. You will also walk through the Southern Nevada Veterans Memorial Cemetery (No Pets allowed!). The Boulder City Municipal Airport is adjacent to cemetery. There are no commercial passenger carriers but tour operations and private aviation make it the 3rd busiest airport in Nevada. Most paths are paved but there are segments of natural and gravel surfaces which might be more challenging for wheelchairs or strollers.
