Proposed Changes to the AVA Policy Manual

(Version 3.2 - 11/13/2018, 11:08AM EDT)

This page is intended to provide a common location for proposed changes to the AVA Policy Manual and supporting documentation.

Proposed AVA Policy changes to cover AVA BOD Member Sanctioned Events (aka RD Walks, President Walks, etc.)

Introduction - In general AVA Board of Directors (BOD) members should avoid sponsoring an event; they should instead encourage clubs to sponsor the event under consideration. But there are good reasons for a BOD member to sanction/conduct an event including:

- * To keep certain key events in place after a club folds or
- * To establish events in specific areas where a local club does not exist (with the plan to establish a club in the area at a later date).
- 1. Any member of the BOD may create an event hereafter referred to as a BOD event.
- 2. A BOD event must be approved by the sanctioning authority (or authorities) for the state and region of the event.
- 3. The AVA shall not assess an event sanctioning fee for an approved BOD event.
- 4. The BOD member shall provide event participation data in a timely fashion for each BOD event they have sanctioned.
- 5. The paid participant fee for a BOD event shall be the maximum allowed participation fee for that event type.
- 6. The BOD member shall remit to the AVA all funds received for the event including the collected paid participant fees and any donations.
- 7. The BOD member shall complete and submit the standard expense form to the AVA to obtain compensation for direct expenses to conduct the event.

Proposed AVA Policy Changes based on Recently Approved NEC/BOD Motions

Cut and Paste of Event Stamps from Insert Cards

- Event stamp imprints from insert cards may be cut into individual stamp imprints and placed into IVV Event/Distance and AVA Special Program books instead of including complete insert cards with these books.
- 2. This is an option open to all AVA participants to permit the completion of books by pasting or taping individual stamps from other official sources into official achievement books.
- 3. Use of staples to affix stamp imprints into books is not allowed.

Submission of Scanned Books

- AVA Associate members (including AVA Lifetime members), may send in (via email or US Mail) scans of their completed achievement books to the AVA versus mailing the actual books to AVA for certification.
- 2. Members who employ scanned books need not send in their Record of Achievement (ROC) books with each submission. Instead the ROC books should be periodicially sent via US Mail to the AVA for update.

Recent changes to the **Policy Manual** deployed on the ava.org website (10/10/2018)

Summary of Changes

Major

- Added new Subsection 4.14 Event Directions and Maps.
- Added new Section 5 AVA Community Events.
- Changed 4.06.II.D to permit sanctioning of events on cruise ships.
- Modified Appendix B to reflect change of annual club dues from \$50 to \$75.
- Modified Appendix B to contain all assessed sanctioning, participation, and processing fees.

Minor

- Removed effectivity dates from policy statements where the dates are now in past.
- Removed the policy statement specifying the use of "Rallyhood" as a electronic communication system.
- Moved dollar amounts of sanctioning fees paid for TGW and GB events into Appendix B.
- Added policy statements that GB and TGW events cannot be sanctioned as PPSF
- Removed outdated/expired statements covering optional 50/50 Special Programs policy that is no longer allowed.
- Removed policy statements about the return of stamps to AVA HQ.
- Added policy statement that clubs should dispose of rubber stamps within 30 days after an event and keep/re-use wooden handles.
- Removed fees for the late return of stamps and the return of damaged stamps from Appendix B.
- Added new/revised fees for stamp and handle replacement as well as "custom stamps" to Appendix B
