
AVA CHECKPOINT

The next meeting of the NEC will be held in beautiful Des Moines, Iowa at the AVA Biennial Convention, June 22 - 24, 2011. The convention itself starts on June 18.

Convention Items by Susan Pinneke, Convention Chair

Convention Registration - Postmarked by May 4: Just a reminder that the deadline for convention registration is fast approaching. Your registration must be postmarked by May 4th to guarantee your registration. After that date, and before May 15th, limited email registration is available. No discounts will apply after May 4th. Be warned the email registration is not working perfectly. Also, very limited registration will be available in Des Moines, at additional cost.

Cow Races: One activity that occurs with every convention is NEC fund raising. For this convention, we are using a cow race theme for this fund raising activity.
