Introduction of Business

I move that: the use of the date slug from all traditional, seasonal and year round events be eliminated on January 1, 2014

Summary of Proposed Action: At present, it costs in excess of \$6,000 to procure and mail out the yearly slug. In addition, clubs must expend energy, time, postage and gas to get these slugs into stamps. It is also difficult to get the stamps changed in time for the new year while keeping old year slug available for last minute participants. The only down side is that Special Programs, as Centurion, which use year slug as a requirement. However, due to the turn in policies of these programs, after a year has lapsed, the books must be turned in.

Elimination of year slug will also afford more room per line for people to personalize their entries instead of squeezing all data in the small block at beginning on line
