CLARIFICATION OF AVA MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS

The October Checkpoint posted notice of a General Membership Meeting on Friday, February 24, 2023. This was an error. The AVA has two types of meetings per our bylaws; a "Regular Membership Meeting" and a "Special Membership Meeting". The Regular Membership Meeting is when the AVA elects National Officers, receives reports from National Officers and Committees, and conducts other business of the organization. This meeting is tentatively scheduled for June 2023, date TBA. This will be an electronic meeting. Dates and times will be posted in the March 2023 Checkpoint.

A Special Membership Meeting may be called by the Board of Directors at any time and the purpose of the meeting shall be stated in the call. CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY FOR REGISTRATION

All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing and may be subject to a \$50.00 cancellation fee for a full 2023 Olympiad and IML TTR registration, and up to \$25.00 for a partial 2023 Olympiad and IML TTR registration. You must contact the American Volkssport Association Inc. (AVA) no later than January 1, 2023, to cancel your registration for the 2023 IVV Olympiad and IML TTR. Cancellations made prior to January 1, 2023, will be eligible for refunds. No refunds will be given for cancellations made after January 1, 2023. EVENT STAMP REMINDER

Stamps are sent out 2 months prior to the event. If you have not received your stamps 3 weeks prior to your event, please let us know as soon as possible. Last minute stamps are time consuming and expensive for everyone. Also if you are sanctioning an event with a start date less than 60 days away, please notify us so that we may determine if there is a need to do a special stamp run to get the event stamp cut and sent prior to the event.

The 2023 stamp process has begun and the Starting Point Books have been ordered. Please make sure all Club and Membership mailing addresses are up to date so there are no packages lost. Stamps and handles for 2023 YRE's and Seasonal events will be mailed by the first week of December.
