Click the above URL to register well in advance of the meeting date.

When you register for the meeting using the above link, if you are a club delegate, alternate, or proxy, be sure to put the same email address you used in the Credentialing Form that was submitted to the Marian at the National Office. Other non-voting meeting attendees should enter their personal email address into the registration form in the above link.

After registering, you will receive a confirmation email containing information about joining the meeting. It is important that you only use the specific URL (link) sent to you via email after you have registered to join the June 14th meeting.

If you are a club voting delegate, alternate, or proxy you will need to enter your personal Delegate Voting Code (DVC) during the meeting Before voting. All club delegates will be emailed their DVCs prior to June 1st. Your DVC will come to the email address you used in the credentialing form. Any club delegate who has not received their DVC by June 1st should contact Marian by email, <a href="mailto:marian@ava.org">marian@ava.org</a>.

#### CLUB DELEGATE VOTING CREDENTIALS AND THEIR USE

All club voting delegates (delegates, alternates, and proxies) who have been certified (so far) will be emailed their Delegate Voting Credentials (DVCs) during the evening of May 31st, 2023.

Those club voting delegates who have not received their DVCs via email by June 2nd:

- 1. Should confirm that the ava.org notification email did not go to their email spam folder.
- 2. Contact their club president to confirm their email was correctly entered in the club delegate selection form.
- 3. Contact Marian (<u>marian@ava.org</u>) to confirm the club delegate email was correctly copied from the club selection form.

All those attending the upcoming online AVA General Meeting on Wednesday June 14th, 2023, at 5pm CT. should register (once) for this meeting using following Zoom registration link:

When registering, all club voting delegates (delegates, alternates, and proxies) should be sure the email address entry box in the registration form, that is often auto filled by your web browser, has been set to the email address in their club's voting delegate selection form.

In response to your registration submission, you will be sent a confirmation email containing a custom meeting link that you need to use (click on) to join the Zoom meeting on June 14th.

During the meeting, when voting begins, all club voting delegates (delegate, alternate, or proxy) will be required to enter (one time) their assigned DVCs sent in a separate ava.org email as described above. Those representing multiple clubs should enter all of their assigned DVCs (one per club) as a comma separated string.

For example, a person representing 2 clubs, one as delegate and the other as an alternate will be sent 2 unique DVCs having the general form DC-123-4567 and AC-890-1234 (arbitrary numbers). When voting begins, these DVCs would need to be entered as "DC-123-4567, AC-890-1234".

All club voting delegates (delegate, alternate, or proxy) present at the meeting should enter all of their DVCs and vote, independent of their roles and the attendance of another club voting delegate of the same club. Once voting is complete, the results will be tabulated to assure that each club with a club voting delegate in attendance gets one vote per polled question. In particular, should a club's designated delegate, alternate and proxy all vote, then only the delegate's vote will be tabulated. Similarly, should a club's alternate and proxy vote then the only alternate's vote will be tabulated.

For those representing multiple clubs, it is possible your vote will be counted multiple times, subject to the conditions noted in the previous paragraph. Vote splitting, i.e., voting one way for one of the clubs you represent, but a different way for another club; is ONLY supported for proxy voters. Proxy voters who need to split their votes must separately collect their Split Vote Information (SVI) during the voting session then, after the voting has ended email the SVI to marian@ava.org. The collected SVI must contain a list of all voting questions along with the club (identified by club number) specific the vote for each question. All received proxy SVIs will be combined with the online voting information to determine the final official vote tabulation, a few days after the general meeting.

Club voting delegate selections received after May 31, 2023, will have their delegate, alternate, and/or proxied DVCs emailed a day or so after the selections have been received.

#### YEAR ROUND AND SEASONAL EVENT RENEWALS FOR 2024 BEGIN JUNE IST, 2023

The renewal of 2023 Year Round and Seasonal events (YRE/SEs) for 2024 will be enabled starting June 1st, 2023. Clubs are expected to complete the renewal of their 2023 YRE/SEs as a well as any new YRE/SEs for 2024 by 8/31/2023.

NOTE: Clubs should NOT use the "New event - copy previous" feature in the Edit/New "NEW EVENTS TO BE COMPLETED" section to renew events.

On June 1st, the my.ava.org system will automatically copy the current (published) event information of each club's sanctioned 2023 YRE/SEs into the Edit/New event buffer. These copied events will then be listed in the "EVENT RENEWALS" section of the club's Edit/New page (found via the club's home page, then clicking on the "Sanctions" tab, then the "Edit/New" tab).

Any unpublished or unapproved changes to 2023 YRE/SEs will NOT be included in the event information copied on June 1st. The club's home page contains a "Edit/New Sanctioning Summary" table providing a count of events needing to be published or approved. Any club YRE/SEs listed in the Edit/New "EDITING CURRENT SANCTIONS" section may have unpublished/unapproved changes. Clicking on the "Review" button, for a listed event, displays all event information with change bars indicating what changes are still pending. Clicking on the displayed "Publish (make public)" or "Req Approval" button near the top of the Review page at least a week prior to June 1st will allow time for regional directors (and possibly state associations) to approve any event changes (needing approval) such that resulting published event information will be included in the corresponding renewal.

On June 1st, all published 2023 YRE/SE information will be copied into the renewal events with the following exceptions:

- 1. The event year will be changed to 2024.
- 2. Special Programs (SPs), that "expire" 12/31/2023, will be removed. (The SP expiration date is the date after which the SP POC will no longer officially accept completed SP books, as indicated on the current SPs web page, https://cb.ava.org/specprog.php)
- 3. The requested number of stamps for each renewal will be set to 1 for PSB and PSB/OSB events and 0 for OSB events. (The previous year's stamp request number is ignored. The first stamp for any event type is always free.)
- 4. The "Request" event to be PPSF (Per Participant Sanctioning Fee) will be NOT be checked off. (The 2023 PPSF setting is ignored.)

Clubs may also choose to mark any listed renewal as "Do Not Renew".

For an event the club chooses to renew, a club manager should click on the listed renewal's "Edit" button. Then inspect/update the information displayed on the Edit page by clicking on each of the "Sanction Tiles" buttons near the top of the page. In particular, the club should consider possibly checking off "Request event be PPSF", adding any applicable/new SPs (starting in 2024, see <a href="https://cb.ava.org/futureprog.php">https://cb.ava.org/futureprog.php</a>), and adjusting the number of requested stamps. Once a renewal's information has been edited and saved, a "Review" page displays all the renewal's information on one page. Clubs must click on the "Req Approval" button (near the top of the "Review" page) to indicate the renewal is ready for regional director (and state association if applicable) approval.

New YRE/SEs for 2024 should also be submitted for approval before August 31st, 2023, to assure their inclusion in the 2024 Starting Point book. Clubs may use the Edit/New page features in the "NEW EVENTS TO BE COMPLETED" and "RESURRECT AN OLD YRE / SEASONAL" sections to create new YRE/SEs as described via the "Help" button on the Edit/New page.

#### YRE RENEWAL

The YRE renewal process will begin June 1, 2023 and will end August 31, 2023.

RD's must review and approve all events by September 15, 2023 in order to get them into the 2023 Starting Point book. Any approvals after the 15th do not guarantee a section in the Starting Point book.
