IMPORTANT DEADLINES FOR APRIL 29TH, 2025, BOARD MEETING AND THE APRIL 30TH AND MAY 2ND, 2025, REGULAR MEMBERSHIP MEETING

March 15, 2025 – (45 days before the Regular Membership meeting)

VOTING DURING THE REGULAR MEMBERSHIP MEETING

The AVA National office is working on an electronic voting application for the Regular Membership meeting during the convention. Once the system has been tested, the AVA will host a couple of webinars on how to use the application prior to the convention. Dates and times of the webinars will be emailed to all club POC's and Delegates and posted on the AVA website. During the convention, members can also stop by the Tech Bar for assistance and a tutorial on how this voting application works. It is critical that all Delegates, Proxies, and Alternates, include their names and email addresses on the Credentialing forms submitted to the National office so instructions and user codes can be emailed to them. More information will be emailed to all club POC's and Delegates as it becomes available. This will be a very simple application that is easy to use.

The candidates are:




Chairperson: Carl Cordes from North Las Vegas, Nevada

In accordance with paragraph 4.06(e) of the Bylaws, nominations from the floor are not allowed.

Per paragraph 4.06(d), "the National Officers shall be elected at large by secret ballot at the regular membership meeting."

However, per paragraph 4.06(f) of the Bylaws, "Where only one candidate for a National Office has been nominated, no ballots shall be cast by the Members, and the Chair shall call for a voice vote of the Members."

During the first session of the General Membership meeting on Wednesday, April 30, the four nominees, following introduction by the Nominating Committee, will be allowed six minutes to address the Members present at the General Membership Meeting per the meeting agenda.

During the second session of the General Membership meeting on Friday, May 2, the election of the nominees shall occur per the meeting agenda.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR TELLERS AND CREDENTIALING

The AVA Secretary is looking for volunteers to serve as Tellers and in Credentialing.

What are tellers you ask? Tellers will assist in vote counting during the AVA's Biennial Convention in Las Cruces. Tellers would need to be available during the business meetings.

What is Credentialling? Credentialing is the process of confirming the delegates, alternates, and proxies, representing each club at the convention and providing them with their credentials to be able to vote in the business meetings. Credentialling also determines if a quorum has been met. Credentialling takes place at various times, such as during convention registration and immediately prior to business meetings. Voting delegates and alternates cannot be Tellers.

Both these positions are necessary for conducting business at the AVA Biennial Convention. Tellers and Credentialling work with the AVA Secretary to ensure that everyone who is eligible to vote is able to and that all votes are counted accurately.

- Friday May 2, 2025, 2:30 P.M. through 4:30 P.M.

Credentialing is tentatively scheduled for:

- Tuesday April 29, 2025, from 2:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M.
- Wednesday April 30, 2025, from 1:00 P.M. to 3:15 P.M.
- Friday May 2, 2025, from 1:00 P.M. to 2:15 P.M.

May 15th, 2025 - The following items are due:

- E-post card must be filed with the IRS and a copy provided to AVA HQ.
- Club's Annual Financial Report is due to the AVA HQ.
- Update of Officers Information in the ESR must be completed by each club.

Note: Financials for clubs with a fiscal year ending 6-30-24 are not due until November 15, 2025

2025 DELEGATE SELECTION AND PROXY DESIGNATION (AVA FORM 500)

The 2025 Delegate Selection and Proxy Designation (AVA Form 500) has been e-mailed to club POC's. Please complete the form, ensure all required signatures are obtained, and retain a copy for your records. Submit the executed form to AVA for credentialing at the Convention. The form must be postmarked or emailed no later than March 15, 2025. If the deadline for returning this form to the National Office is missed, the form must accompany the Delegate, Alternate, or Proxy to the Credentials Booth at the Convention.
